



## VACANCY – Full Time Apprentice (Civil Engineering)

Yorkshire and Humber Drainage Boards represent 8 flood risk management authorities. Our work reduces flood risk to thousands of residents, businesses, property, and infrastructure. We operate 83 pumping stations, maintain over 800 miles of watercourses and rivers that drain over 360 square miles of the region.

As a local public authority, we have a culture that supports the development of future technical specialists working in our sector, so are offering an Apprenticeship in Civil Engineering

The successful applicant will complete a Level 2 or Level 3 college course in Civil Engineering (depending on entry requirements) and will work alongside an experienced team of flood risk managers and flood risk technical specialists. All reasonable travel expenses and resources needed for college, including a laptop will be provided.

Duties will include working with colleagues to manage a range of flood risk assets including flood defences, pumping stations and bridges. Other duties will include mapping and organisation of planned maintenance works and developing new infrastructure schemes.

Although this apprenticeship has a civil engineering bias, there will be opportunities to work in other service areas within the wider organisation, including operations, development control, finance, and democratic services.

After successful completion of the qualification there may be an opportunity to progress within the organisation.

The successful candidate will be motivated and inquisitive with a desire to join a team that operates some of the most important infrastructure in the region.

The role comes with a remuneration in line with national minimum wage requirements for apprentices, generous leave and automatic enrolment into the Local Government Pension scheme. The employer is Ouse and Humber Drainage Board, the apprentice will normally be based at our headquarters in Newport, Brough, East Yorkshire.
